<p>Art Research Greek pottery designs. Can you draw, paint or create a collage of a Greek vase, including traditional patterns and scenes?</p>

<p>Music Learn a simple Greek dance or listen to traditional Greek music. Can you perform it for your family or teach them a few steps?</p>

<p>Art Research Greek mythical creatures (e.g., Minotaur, Pegasus, Hydra). Draw or create a model of your favourite one.</p>

<p>PSHE Choose a significant Greek figure from history (e.g., Archimedes, Hippocrates, Pythagoras, Sappho). Create a fact file or PowerPoint explaining why they were important.</p>

<p>Maths Create a table showing the lengths of different Greek architectural features (e.g., column heights, temple widths).</p>

<p>Computing Using Google Sites, create a simple website explaining one aspect of Ancient Greek life- such as democracy, myths, or the Olympics.</p>

<p>PE Design your own Olympic training routine inspired by the Ancient Greek games. Include warm-ups, skills and fitness activities.</p>
