

# Project glossary

## **art gallery**

A building where pieces of artwork are displayed.

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## **collage**

A picture made from a range of materials such as fabric, paper and card.

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## **compare**

To look at the similarities and differences between two things.

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## **composition**

The way things or people are arranged in a piece of artwork.

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## **embellishment**

A decorative feature added to something to make it more attractive.

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## **exhibition**

A group of artworks in an art gallery.

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## **facial feature**

A part of the face, such as the nose, eye, mouth, ear or cheek.

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## **form**

The 3-D aspect of a piece of artwork.

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## **painting**

A picture made by putting paint on a surface.

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## **photograph**

A picture of a person, object or view taken using a camera.

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## **self-portrait**

A portrait that an artist makes of themselves.



**sequin**

A small, shiny metal or plastic disc often used as an embellishment.

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**subject**

The person, place or thing that is the main focus of a piece of artwork.

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**texture**

The surface of a piece of artwork, such as rough or smooth.
